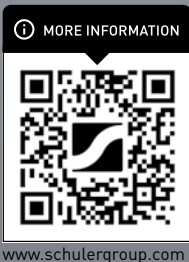

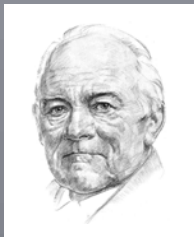
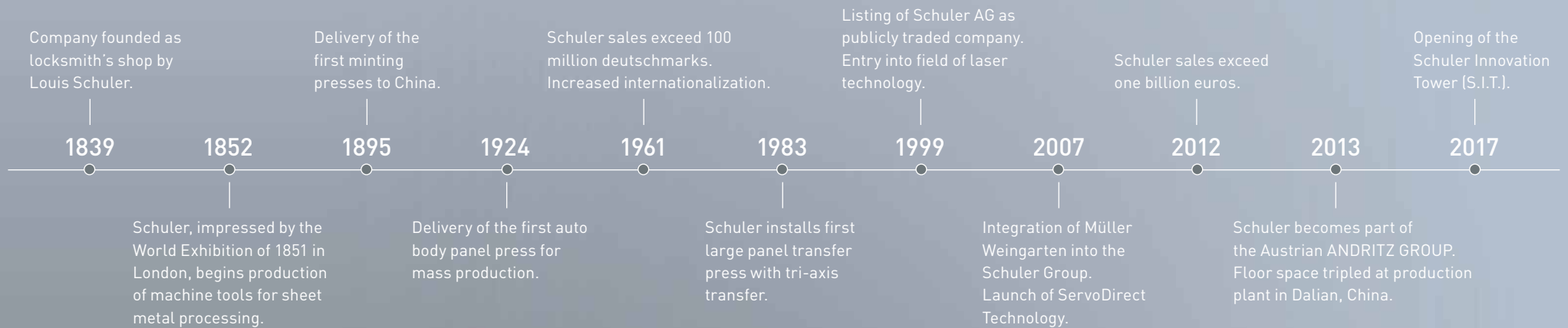
Schuler is the world's largest manufacturer of presses and equipment, primarily for the automotive industry and its suppliers, but also for many other metal-working industries. From coins, beverage cans and coffee capsules to sinks and hotplates as well as entire side walls for car bodies: our machines can be used to form a wide variety of parts – not only from steel and aluminum, but also from carbon, for example. Press forces of thousands of tons are required for products such as railway wheels. The systems can assume dimensions of several meters in height and hundreds of meters in length. Schuler has had its headquarters in Göppingen since it was founded in 1839. During this time, the group has sold more than 100,000 presses worldwide.
